## Overall Evaluations up to now

During the pilot phase 2004-2007, the ProFiL Programme was evaluated externally. The evaluation has been carried out internally since 2007 in order to ensure continuous quality assurance. In the completed evaluations of the 1st-13th round, the ProFiL Programme received very good overall ratings (average values on a scale from 1 = very good to 6 = unsatisfactory).

## Status Changes among ProFiL Participants up to now

As of 24 March 2023, **245** participants have attained formal eligibility for professorship. At the same time, **335** participants were appointed as W3/W2 professors, as full/associate/assistant professors or as readers/lecturers. **14** participants are/were appointed vice-presidents at their universities and **4** participants were appointed director or (vice-) president at a non-university research organisation or academy. One participant was awarded the Leibniz Prize.
