Seminars

We have decided for two one-day seminars in this PhD workshop. We will have the presentation skills seminar on Monday afternoon and Tuesday morning, and the science outreach seminar on Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday morning.

Presentation skills seminar

Giving talks and presenting our results to other scientists is a crucial part of being a PhD student. This seminar aims to help us improve our presentation techniques and to learn new skills. For this purpose we have invited Dr. Carsten Rohr (www.carstenrohr.de) as an expert on this field. The topics covered by his workshop are as follows:

- Planning and structure.
- Memorable start and ending.
- Speech, voice and body language.
- Visualization and presentation of media.
- *If requested: slide composition*

Important! In this workshop we will apply the learned material to our own presentations. Therefore everybody should **bring either a scientific presentation or poster to work with (old or upcoming ones).**

Science outreach seminar

Another important part is to also present our research to a broad audience. How can we increase the impact of our research? How can we reach people from other fields than just our narrow research area? And how do we use the appropriate images, media etc. for that purpose? To answer these questions we invited Dr. Jens Kube (www.jenskube.de) as an expert. He will cover the following topics:

- Introduction to science outreach.
- Figure out the core messages of one's own work.
- Apt use of technical terms.
- Structuring public talks, using images, media and objects.
- Use of humor and presenting the work as a story.

All the above topics will be covered with a mixture of lectures, action-oriented exercises, duo/team exercises, individual tasks and feedback-oriented exercises.

Group work

On Thursday morning, we have time for some common work. We will set out to formulate CRC project descriptions in an easily comprehensible manner, using the knowledge gained in the Science outreach seminar. This will help us better explain the aim and overall picture of the CRC to the general public and scientists from a different field.

Freetime activities

On Wednesday afternoon there will be time for common outdoor activities such as swimming in lake Plau (bring your swimsuit!) or exploring the area. In the evening we could join the “Musikerstammtisch”, a regular meeting of musicians which takes place at Schloss Plau (<http://www.schlossplau.de/events.php>).


